Background

Thank you to all who have responded to my previous update with an interest in the project and who have provided me with a list of the species that you are particularly interested in.

I have created an initial list comprising 54 species and commonly used names that you are using as well as the results of an internet search of Australian suppliers..

The initial list of standard aquatic names will be confined to edible aquatic plants so some of these will probably drop off the final list.

As I stated in previous updates, there will be minimal involvement required from stakeholders with most work being done by the project manager. What is now needed is:

1. Peruse this list below to make sure that any species that you are handling are listed;
2. If you have species that are NOT on the list or a preferred name that is not listed, provide me with the details and your preferred names at asnow@frdc.com.au

3. Your support for the project and agreement to be listed as a key stakeholder and to provide feedback;
4. Assist the project by identifying other stakeholder or stakeholder groups that have not been identified and forwarding this email or providing me with the details..

Date for Aquatic Plant Name Workshop

One of the last steps in the development of the draft Aquatic Plant Name Standard will be a workshop in Hobart to finalise and agree on the list of plant names. The date for this workshop has been set for 6 September 2018. I will be seeking interest from prospective participants to finalise travel arrangements within the next month.

A steering committee has been formed to provide guidance on the project. The next step is to start formulating a list of commercial species of aquatic plants that should be added to the standard.

Your continuing support in this project would be greatly appreciated and will greatly assist your industry.
